Tax Levy Ordinance No. 122021-22

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for **Burton Township**, McHenry County, Illinois. For the tax year 2021, which is collectable in 2022

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of **Burton Township**, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1:

That the sum one hundred sixty-five thousand two hundred ninety-four dollars and No Cents (**\$165,294.00**) are hereby levied upon all property that is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

1. General Town Fund
2. Public Assistance Fund


**CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
TRUTH IN TAXATION
TOWN LEVY**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of *Burton*
(Legal Name of Taxing District)

and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The proposed aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held.
